The sessions are a follow-up to informational sessions held in June. During this round of meetings, focus groups will be conducted, providing attendees a forum to share

thoughts and feedback about the current state of LTSS in an effort to help guide development of the ICN program.

State legislation passed in 2015 established a competitively bid, integrated network to provide long-term care services to Medicaid recipients. Patterned after Regional Care Organization legislation, the new law creates a provider-organized, at-risk system that is to begin no later than October 1, 2018.
