Provider Standards Committee

- **Established by law and Administrative Code Rule 560-X-62-.09**
- **Create performance benchmarks related to the efficiency and management of services provided to beneficiaries**
- **Numeric quantification of results or outcomes of high-quality outcomes**

- **Established by law and Administrative Code Rule 560-X-62-.09**


PSC standards should not to include

- **Application of such standards in contracts between an RCO and a provider**

Regionally Based




How will I know when Standards Are Created?



PSC Timeline for Development



Dates are subject to RCO business plans
Suggested time needed to accommodate overall implementation timelines.

Accounts for developing committee and
For committee to publish for RCO and
Provider feedback.

RCOs must allow at least 45 days for Agency approval of
Provider Agreement
Templates for use in network
development so as to meet
overall full-risk requirements.

RCOs will need signed
Agreements in April
timeframe to report on
adequacy of their network by
May '16.
