  - Allows user to key in medications to find relevant prescription assistance programs that may help decrease drug costs.
  - Over 1,000 medications at no cost or at a discounted price

  - Non-profit organization
  - Alphabetical lists of Prescription Assistance Programs
  - Frequently updated
  - NeedyMeds Drug Discount card available

    - ✓ No age requirement
  - Free supply of medication is mailed to your home or physician's office
  - Coverage is limited to Astra-Zeneca products
  - 1 year enrollment. Can reapply after that year.

    - ✓ 250% of federal poverty level

    - ✓ Medications at little to no cost
  - 1 year enrollment period

    - ✓ 200% of federal poverty level
  - 90 day supply of medications will be provided through the physician’s office at no cost to the advocate or recipient
  - 1 year enrollment period

- Qualifications:
    - ✓ No age or income requirements
  - Program covers brand and generic medications at a discounted price
    - ✓ Savings up to 75%
    - ✓ Over 63,000 participating pharmacies
    - ✓ Manufacturer rebates on broad range of brand name medications

    - ✓ No public or private prescription drug coverage

  - Offers more than 40 prescription medications
  - 1 year enrollment period

- Qualifications:
    - ✓ 300% of federal poverty level
    - ✓ No age requirement
    - ✓ Must use Lilly brand medications
  - Offers many Lilly brand medications for free
  - 1 year enrollment
  - Eli Lilly ships up to 4 months of medication to your physician’s office

- Qualifications:
    - ✓ No age requirement
    - ✓ Certain income requirements. See website for more details
    - ✓ No insurance or other coverage for your Merck prescriptions
  - Provides free Merck medicines to people who qualify
  - 1 year enrollment. Individuals may reapply as many times as needed.

    - ✓ 250-500% of federal poverty level depending on Novartis medication
    - ✓ No age requirement
  - Determines individual needs and provides contact information for the appropriate program via short questionnaire
  - Coverage is limited to Novartis products

- Qualifications (see website for more details)
    - ✓ No Age or income requirements
  - Coverage is limited to Pfizer products
    - ✓ 15- 36% discount on covered medications
    - ✓ 1 year enrollment period

- Qualifications:
    - ✓ At least 55 years old or deemed disabled by social security and in the 24 month gap for Medicare coverage
    - ✓ Chronic medical condition
    - ✓ In Medicare Part D gap
    - ✓ 200% of federal poverty level
  - Helps thousands of Alabamians receive free prescription drugs
  - Medications donated from various pharmaceutical manufacturers

- Qualifications:
    - ✓ Residents of Alabama
    - ✓ No age or income requirements
  - Program covers brand and generic medications at discounted price
    - ✓ Savings up to 75% (average savings around 30%)
    - ✓ Over 56,000 participating pharmacies
    - ✓ Free Card activated online
  - No cost to enroll, no restrictions
- 2) **Commitment to Access** [GlaxoSmithKline] – 866-265-6491: [www.gskcta.com](http://www.gskcta.com)
- Qualifications:
    - ✓ 500% of federal poverty level (see website for more details)
  - Program provides assistance with copayments and coinsurance for oncology and specialty drugs
    - ✓ Coverage is limited to GSK products
  - Amount of assistance varies based on income level

- Qualifications:
    - ✓ No age or income requirements
  - Program covers brand and generic medications at a discounted price
    - ✓ Savings up to 75%
    - ✓ Over 63,000 participating pharmacies
    - ✓ Manufacturer rebates on broad range of brand name medications

- Qualifications (see website for more details)
    - ✓ 250% of federal poverty level
    - ✓ Must have Medicare Part D
    - ✓ Must provide proof of out of pocket payments of \$600 in prescription expenses for the year
    - ✓ No age requirement
  - Coverage is limited to GSK products
  - Medications are provided at no cost to the recipient
  - Enrollment for 1 year

- Qualifications:
    - ✓ Must have Medicare Part D
    - ✓ Certain income requirements (see website for more details)
  - Offers certain Lilly medications for free
  - 90 day supply of medicine will be shipped to your home
  - One year enrollment period

- Qualifications (see website for more details)
    - ✓ 300% of federal poverty level
    - ✓ No age requirements
  - Prescriptions are shipped to the recipient's home
  - Program only covers generic medications
  - 90-180 day supplies of more than 380 medications
  - Enrollment lasts for 1 year. After 1 year you may re-enroll
