## PUBLIC NOTICE

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

The Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend its State Plan for Medical Assistance through a State Plan Amendment. The purpose of the State Plan Amendment is to use the authority of section 1902(r)(2) of the Social Security Act to have a block income disregard between the current net income standard of 100% FPL and a gross income standard of 141% for the mandatory poverty-level related group of children aged 6 through 18 under section 1902(a)(10)(A)(i)(VII) of the Act. The State Plan Amendment will allow for the alignment of Medicaid MAGI income standards for all children regardless of age, effective January 1, 2014.

A copy of the proposed changes will be made available upon request for public review at the State Office of the Alabama Medicaid Agency.
