

## **Change to the Alabama Medicaid 1095-B Form Process**

March 26, 2021

A law changed and now most people do not need proof of Medicaid coverage in order to file their taxes. Therefore, Alabama Medicaid will not mail a 1095-B form to recipients this year.

If you still need a 1095-B form, you can ask for it by phone, email, or mail.
