Maternity Recipients

The ACHN will help you make better choices in order to have better health outcomes for you and your baby.

The nurses, social workers and/or other staff members can help you:

- Better understand and manage your health condition.
- Coordinate services.
- Find community resources.

If you are pregnant and on Medicaid, you must contact the ACHN in your region to help you get maternity services. You may be responsible to pay for your maternity care if you do not contact the ACHN in your region.





The ACHN will work with you to help you get the care you need.

Dental services are available for pregnant recipients through 60 days postpartum or until the pregnancy ends.

ACHN will help you:

- Find a doctor or OB/GYN and learn how to get services in the best place.
- Make appointments, follow up with you to help you keep appointments, assist with referrals, and provide appointment reminders.
- Find resources so you can have a better quality of life.
- Answer questions about maternity care.
- Stop smoking and/or stop tobacco use.
- Get a referral for family planning services.
