

Medicaid Coverage of Medications and Durable Medical Equipment/Supplies for Maternity Care Recipients

1. Medications

Any medications prescribed for a pregnant woman are covered if the drug is covered through the Medicaid Pharmacy Program. The medication must be prescribed by the Delivering Health Care Professional or specialty physician and presented to an active Medicaid pharmacy provider. The prescribed drug will be subject to all applicable Medicaid policy. Pharmacy providers should dispense the drug at no cost to the recipient.

2. Durable Medical Equipment/Supplies

Pregnant women with Type I, Type II or gestational diabetes are eligible to receive diabetic equipment/supplies from an active Medicaid Equipment (DME) Supplier. Not all pharmacies are DME suppliers.
